Partners in Scholarship (PINS) Awards Program

The Camp Atwater Alumni Association (hereinafter also referred to as the Alumni Association, CAAA or the Association) scholarship program is designed to recognize youths for excellence in performance that is acknowledged and recognized during Black History Month or other authorized period.

Full Scholarship Award (FSA)

The association will ideally provide two full scholarships - one for boys' season and one for girls' season. If the budget cannot be provided for two scholarships, one scholarship will be authorized.

Eligibles for full scholarships will be nominees for whom written recommendations with supportive documentation have been submitted. The recommendation will describe the outstanding performance/achievement in areas such as academics, community service, etc.

Only nominations submitted during the designated period will be considered. Nominations will be reviewed and selections (with runner ups) made by a neutral individual, group or organization designated by the executive committee.

50/50 Partners Scholarship Award (PSA)

The balance of the budget remaining after the designation of full scholarships will be used to provide 50% scholarships based upon two or four week sessions. These 50% scholarships will be simultaneously awarded with the 50% partner share

Partners scholarships will be granted to organizations who officially partner with the Association.

Partner organizations will develop and put forth recognition programs that will allow youths, who are interested in an Atwater experience, to compete and/or demonstrate their abilities. The final selection (with a runner up in the event the selected child is unable to attend) will be made by the partner organization in a manner they determine.

- § Coordinate and conduct a Black History Month (or other appropriate) youth recognition program to allow/provide for youth to compete for an "Atwater Experience"
